Well done, FS1C!






FS2A

MATHS IN ACTION IN YEAR 6

In Year 6, our students dove into the world of mathematics with enthusiasm and curiosity! They explored concepts that strengthen their problem-solving skills and applied them to real-life situations. Each lesson is a step towards building their confidence in math while fostering critical thinking. We are proud of their progress and look forward to seeing how they continue to grow in this essential subject!



BINARY IN ACTION: HOW COMPUTERS TALK WITH YEAR 7

In a 20-minute ICT mini-workshop, students explored how computers use binary to send messages. Using breadboards with buttons and LEDs, they first tried a “manual” communication system: one student pressed a button to blink an LED in a pattern, while a partner decoded the flashes into letters and words. Next, they used an Arduino Nano to automate the process. Typing a word into the program allowed the Arduino to instantly encode it into binary and blink multiple LEDs at once—demonstrating how computers send complex messages faster and more reliably than humans.



THE MAGICAL ELEPHANT TOOTHPASTE REACTION WITH YEAR 8

Our Year 8 students had an exciting science class in the lab, exploring the magical Elephant Toothpaste reaction! They eagerly mixed ingredients and witnessed a spectacular chemical reaction that produced a colorful foam eruption. This hands-on experience sparked curiosity and excitement for science among our young learners. We can't wait to see how experiments like these inspire the scientists of tomorrow!





PHYSICS IN YEAR 9
